2012-2013 SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA INFORMATION SHEET

Scholarships are available for qualifying students, some regardless of their need for financial aid. However, *all scholarship applicants are required to file the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).*

Students wishing to be considered for a scholarship from Eastern Gateway Community College should use the following checklist to make sure their application is complete and processing is not delayed.

- ❑ *Filed the 2012-2013 FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid). Fill out your free FAFSA at www.fafsa.gov. EGCC School Code 007275. We urge everyone to use the IRS Data Retrieval Process when prompted!*
- ❑ *Scholarship Application (completed and signed)*
- ❑ *High School Transcript/ GED*
- ❑ *Essay detailing achievements and goals*
- ❑ *Letter of recommendation from Advisor, Faculty Member, Counselor, Clergy*
- ❑ *Acceptance letter from 4-year college (EGCC Transfer Scholarship Only)*

Priority will be given to applications received by the deadline of March 1, 2012 but applications will be accepted until all scholarships have been awarded.

Scholarships Available for Full-Time Students

ALUMNI SCHOLARSHIP - \$500

Awarded to students entering his/her second year at EGCC. Evaluation criteria for this award include community involvement, motivation to obtain career goals, grade point average and accomplishments. Financial need must be demonstrated. *Four (4) \$500 scholarships will be awarded for 2012-2013.*

DEFENBAUGH SCHOLARSHIP - \$500

Eligible candidates must be pursuing an Associate Degree. Must have completed 30 credit hours. Financial need must be demonstrated.

SAMUEL & GRACE H. JOHNSTON SCHOLARSHIP - \$1200

Awarded to students enrolled in the Engineering or Computer Science programs. Applicants must be working toward an Associate Degree and have a minimum G.P.A. of 3.0 from EGCC or matriculating from their high school. Priority will be given to incoming first time students. Possibility of more than one recipient for this award. If all costs are covered under federal or state financial aid, the student is ineligible for this scholarship

STEVEN E. STRUPE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP - \$1,000

Applicants must be a candidate for graduation of the Buckeye Local School District or district that incorporates Buckeye Local should a consolidation ever occur in the year the scholarship application is made. The student must have attained a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or better at the time the scholarship application is made. The applicant must be pursuing a degree or certificate at the College. Priority consideration will be given to students planning to enroll in an Engineering program.

Scholarships Available for Full or Part-Time Students

AMERICAN ELECTRIC POWER (AEP) *major must pertain to electric industry*****

Applicants must be an AEP Ohio Customer or son or daughter of such customer with a primary residence served by AEP Ohio. They must be receiving service at the time of the scholarship award. Must be enrolled for the purpose of earning an associate degree or formal certificate. Applicants must have attained a high school (or college attended) grade point average of at least 2.75 or the GED equivalent. *Total household income must be 200% of poverty level.* Recipient must maintain a grade point average of at least 2.75 each semester or forfeit the scholarship award. Can award up to the amount of tuition and fees for eligible recipient (lesser amounts depending on funding levels).

BERKMAN SCHOLARSHIP

Employees or dependants of the Louis Berkman Company will receive first consideration. If there are no Louis Berkman employees or dependents, the scholarships are available to assist other qualified students pursuing an Associate Degree or Certificate at EGCC. Can award up to the amount of tuition and fees for eligible recipient (lesser amounts depending on funding level). If an applicant has received financial aid to cover all costs, the student would be ineligible for the scholarship.

Scholarships Available for Full or Part-Time Students (continued)

ARTHUR J. D'ANNIBALLE SCHOLARSHIP - \$250 (*6 hours minimum)

Applicants must be a graduate of Steubenville High School or Catholic Central High School. Student must have maintained at least a 2.5 GPA in high school or at EGCC. Must be pursuing an Associate Degree or Certificate and enroll on at least a half-time basis (minimum 6 cr. hours). Applicants must first apply for all available federal and state funding. If an applicant has received financial aid to cover all costs, the student would be ineligible for the scholarship.

MR. & MRS. JOHN DI LORETO & CONNOR MEEKS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP - \$1,500

Applicants must have completed at least one semester of college work and have attained a cumulative GPA of at least 2.5 and must reside within the Edison Local School District. The monies will be directly applied toward the payment of tuition and fees. Any funds remaining will be put on a charge account at the college bookstore for the student to use towards the purchase of required books and supplies. Recipient must enroll on at least a half-time basis (6 or more credit hours).

DISPLACED WORKERS SCHOLARSHIP

Applicants must be a resident of Jefferson County and must be considered a displaced worker. A displaced worker is a worker who has been permanently laid off, or has received a notice of layoff or termination from employment due to the company's failure or plant closure. Documentation must be provided with application. Recipient must enroll on at least a half-time basis (6 or more credit hours). *Five (5) \$1,250 scholarships will be awarded.*

EGCC FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP - \$500 (*6 hours minimum)

Intended for non-traditional students ineligible for financial assistance, residing in Ohio or the counties of Brooke, Hancock, Marshall, Ohio or Wetzel in West Virginia.

EGCC SCHOLARSHIP - \$500 (*6 hours minimum)

Applicant must be pursuing an Associate Degree or Certificate with a minimum G.P.A. of 3.0 and have completed 24 credit hours.

EGCC SECOND CHANCE SCHOLARSHIP - up to \$2000

Assists students ineligible for Federal and/or State funding because of previous academic performance. Need to be pursuing a Certificate or an Associate Degree. Covers tuition, fees, books and supplies up to \$2000 depending on enrollment.

EDITH FORESTER SCHOLARSHIP - \$120

Intended for students accepted into the Practical Nursing program for the 2012-2013 academic year, who have established a minimum G.P.A. of 3.0. Student must be a resident of Jefferson County and show financial need after Federal and State funding is applied.

Scholarships Available for Full or Part-Time Students (continued)

NINA GENTILE SCHOLARSHIP - \$500 (*6 hours minimum)

Incoming freshmen residing in Jefferson County pursuing an Associate Degree or Certificate with a 2.5 G.P.A. or above documented from an official high school transcript are eligible. Federal and State funding must be applied first. *Two first-year students will receive this scholarship*

HART SCHOLARSHIP - \$300

Available to a Jefferson County resident pursuing an Associate Degree in Accounting. Must be in his/her last semester in the program.

McCLELLAN TRUST FUND - \$750

Applicants must demonstrate academic success with a G.P.A. of 2.75 or above. Must be pursuing an Associate Degree or Certificate. Must demonstrate financial need. *Up to three recipients may be selected.*

NICK A. MOUGIANIS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP - \$750

Applicants must be a resident of Jefferson County or one of the West Virginia Reciprocity counties (Brooke, Hancock, Ohio, Marshall and Wetzel) and demonstrate academic success with a G.P.A. of 2.00 or above in high school or at EGCC. Must be pursuing an Associate Degree or Certificate. If an applicant has received financial aid to cover all tuition, fees and book costs, the student would be ineligible for the scholarship.

HELEN L. & JAMES F. MURRAY SCHOLARSHIP - \$500

Graduates of Steubenville High School pursuing an Associate Degree at EGCC. Must have a minimum G.P.A. of 2.0.

KIMBERLY J. PATTERSON SCHOLARSHIP - \$250

This scholarship is for new or continuing students. Applicants must be pursuing an Associate Degree or Certificate. Must have a cumulative grade point average of 2.0 or better at EGCC or from high school. Applicants must first apply for all available federal and state funding. If an applicant has received financial aid to cover all costs, the student would be ineligible for the scholarship.

Project BEST SCHOLARSHIP - \$1000

Any employee or dependent child of participating contractor and/or construction trade union entering EGCC pursuing an Associate Degree. An employment verification form is required and can be obtained from Project BEST or any participating contractor or labor union. *\$\$ Two (2) \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded. \$\$*

Scholarships Available for Part-Time Only Students

NAYLOR SCHOLARSHIP - \$500

Applicants must be a resident of Jefferson County (Ohio) or Brooke or Hancock County (WV). Student must show academic success in pursuing an Associate Degree with a minimum of 25 credits achieved. Should demonstrate financial need and be involved in activities within the college and in the community. *\$\$ Ten (10) \$500 scholarships are available for the 2012-2013 award year. \$\$*

Scholarship Available for EGCC Students Transferring to 4-Year College

EGCC Transfer Scholarship - \$1,000

Awarded to an EGCC student who is transferring (and accepted) to another accredited college or university for a Bachelor's Degree program of any major. Student must have a 3.0 GPA from EGCC or higher. Applicants must have successfully completed 2 semesters as a full time student at EGCC before transferring. *Student must complete a 200 word essay on "The Educational Importance" of the student's selected field of study. This is separate from the essay for all other scholarships appearing in this application. \$\$ Two (2) \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded. \$\$*
