

## GATEWAY WELLNESS CENTER OPENS



The new Gateway Wellness Center on the Jefferson County Campus of Eastern Gateway Community College opened to the students and public in August.

The new center, located on the second level of the college's Pugliese Center on John Scott Highway, Steubenville, is accessed from the upper level parking lot.

The college used \$1.5 million in donations and state of Ohio capital funds to build the wellness center and college administrative offices. The 12,000-square-foot project was financed by a \$500,000 donation from the Charles M. And Thelma M. Pugliese Charitable Foundation and \$1 million in allocated capital improvement funds. The college saved several biennium allocations, received from the state for capital improvements to the college.

In response to student requests, the college developed the wellness center to serve students on the Jefferson County Campus as well as employees and the general public.

Students are assessed an activity fee each semester while other members will have monthly memberships.

The college chose the YMCA of East Liverpool to manage the facility. The Gateway Wellness Center features various machines, weight stations, will eventually include exercise classes and has men and women locker rooms. The center will be open Monday-Friday, 7 a.m.-8 p.m., Saturday 7 a.m.-6 p.m. and Sunday 11 a.m.-5 p.m. Monthly membership for the public to the Gateway Wellness Center is \$31.03 per adult.

Another part of the second floor renovation is new administrative offices. Due to the growth of the college, its workforce and its services, additional space is needed. Eight offices, a board room and storage were built on the John Scott Highway side of the Pugliese Center. Offices are used by the college president, vice president of administrative services, institutional advancement, public information and other staff.

# ALUMNI STAR SEARCH PICKS WILLIAM MOON

He was the first field engineer in the U.S. to successfully complete Schlumberger Technologies' cross-functional program. He designed and wrote engineering software for an IBM computer product, and defined and released multiple ISDN, ATM and Ethernet telecom products to the market.

Moon belongs to the Thoburn United Methodist Church, where he serves on the Visioning Committee. He is a member of the Wheeling Rotary Club. He is past president of technology for the ISDN Vendor's Association.

## FALL ENROLLMENT BOOMS PAST THE 2,400 MARK

Enrollment is booming at Eastern Gateway Community College. Fall headcount surged past the 2,400 mark for the first time in college history.

The 15 percent growth from last fall sets the student population at 2,456 with 56 percent of the students from Jefferson County, 18 percent from Mahoning County, 6 percent from Trumbull County and 5 percent from Columbiana County. The new student count grew by 17 percent.

Enrollment in online classes continues to grow at Eastern Gateway. Nearly 35 percent of all students take at least one online class.

Another positive note from this historical growth is the number of classes being held at the career centers and the college's Warren Center, said President Dr. Laura Meeks. "The growth of these classes was slow at the start, but the schedule and locations are catching on with the residents. This is great news for the college and our partners."

## NEW PARALEGAL DEGREE OFFERED AT EGCC

Eastern Gateway Community College announced its new paralegal program, which began classes this fall on the Jefferson County Campus.

"Eastern Gateway is excited to offer this new career program for area residents," said Professor Bernie Levite, who developed the program which carries the approval of the Ohio Board of Regents. "This program has been requested repeatedly by members of the community so we are happy to deliver this new career option."

The classes designed for the program include subjects such as Paralegal Research and Writing I & II, Real Property/Real Estate Law, Litigation /Civil Procedures, Estate Law, Family Law, Torts, Contracts, and Criminal Law. General education and technical elective courses will complete the curriculum for both the associate's degree and certificate programs.

A paralegal is a non-lawyer who assists lawyers in their legal work. This includes performing legal preparations such as closings, hearings, trials, and corporate meetings. Other duties include the gathering of relevant facts of cases, identifying appropriate law and decisions, organizing information, preparing legal arguments, to identify a few. Paralegals work in government agencies, law firms, corporations, real estate firms as well as non-profit organizations.

The paralegal profession is considered one of the fastest growing professions today, according to the Occupational Outlook Handbook. The demand over the next 10 years is expected to increase by 52 percent. Beginning salaries for graduates with an associate degree in paralegal studies is about \$35,000, varying based on location.

To enter the degree program, students must be a high school or GED graduate. The program will be offered at the college's other locations in the future.

Eastern Gateway is ready to help students to prepare for a paralegal career. Advisors and instructors help students to determine a course of preparation and instruction. For more information about the paralegal program at Eastern Gateway, call Admissions at 800.68.COLLEGE x212.

# SURPRISE NOMINATION LEADS TO QUEEN COURT

Sheila Gulasi Robinson was nearing the end of her degree program at Eastern Gateway Community College in 1972 when she got the surprise of her life: The school's all-male engineering department had nominated her to represent them on Queen's Court.

"There were no girls in the engineering department, so they nominated me," said Sheila, who at the time was pursuing a business degree at the former Jefferson County Technical Institute. "It was cool. I was so proud - and to get it from the engineering department boys. I was just so excited to be nominated. Then all the students from the school voted and they chose me."

There weren't many duties involved with being queen - at least, not that she remembers. As queen, Sheila reigned at the school's annual spring graduation formal and returned a year later to crown her successor. In between, she'd graduated with an associate's degree in applied business and found work in a local steel mill.

"Three days before I graduated in 1972, I got a job as the private secretary, a temporary job, as executive secretary for the vice president and director of environmental control for National Steel, but it was in the Weirton office," she said. "I liked it. From there, I worked in labor relations as a stenographer, in the billing office as a clerk. I worked in different places, where ever they needed me."

A 1969 graduate of Madonna High School in Weirton, Sheila married a steelworker, and when the first of their two children was born she left the mill to be a stay-at-home mom. But when the kids were old enough she went back to school, eventually earning her bachelor's in secondary education from West Liberty University in 1991 and her master's in technology education from West Virginia University in 2002.

For the past 10 years she's taught business at Oak Glen High School, where she's more than willing to give Eastern Gateway props for helping its students build careers or transition to four-year degree programs.

"I'm glad I took the path I did," she said. "I think it was good I started my education at Jeff Tech - it was a good stepping stone for me. I always tell my students about it, about my good experience there."
